

# Accessibility guide for MusiQuest



MusiQuest is for every child and young person wanting to take part. Here is a way you can make the quest work for you particularly if you may need help with reading or understanding the words better 😊

## Enable Siri, Cortana or Alexa for reading aloud

To help with reading, you can ask your online assistant for help. Make sure your settings on your device are set to enable this feature.



### How to Enable Speak Screen Feature in iOS

Before you can use the Speak Screen ability, you will need to enable it. This feature requires a modern version of iOS for iPhone or iPad, so if you do not find the option then you may need to update the system software of the device:

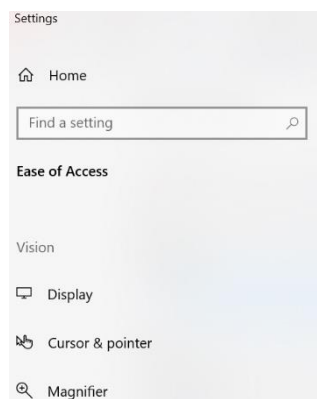
1. Open the 'Settings' app in iOS
2. Go to 'General' and then to "Accessibility"
3. Go to the "Speech" section and flip the switch for "Speak Screen" to the ON position \*

### How to enable Google text to speech



In order to use this great feature, you should enable it first. On many Android devices, it is already enabled. To turn Google text to speech on, follow these steps:

- Navigate to Settings
- Tap on Language & Input
- Now tap on the Text-to-speech output located at the bottom of the screen



#### Narrator

Narrator is a screen reader that describes what's on your screen so you can use that information to navigate your device. It can be controlled by keyboard, touch and mouse.

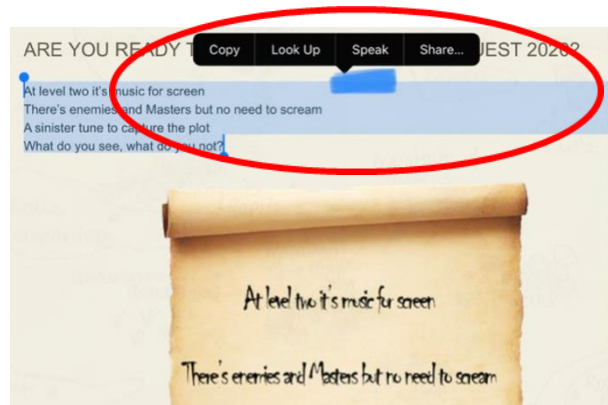

## Text to speech output

To specify text to speech settings for your device:



1. Open your device's Settings app .
2. Select **Accessibility**, then **Text-to-speech output**.
3. Choose your preferred engine, language, speech rate and pitch.
  - **Note:** The default text-to-speech engine choices vary by device. Options can include Google's text-to-speech engine, the device manufacturer's engine and any third-party text-to-speech engines that you've downloaded from the Google Play Store.
4. Optional: To hear a short demonstration of speech synthesis, press **Play**.
5. Optional: To install voice data for another language, select Settings , then **Install voice data**. Choose the language that you want to install.
