

Babethandaza Video Guidelines

We would love your school to take part in our city-wide musical project using the beautiful South African song, *Babethandaza*. This project provides an opportunity for every Nottingham City pupil to get involved.

There are two streams of lesson resources.

The first is a series of 5 lessons aimed at pupils without instruments. A brief outline of these lessons can be found below:

Lesson 1: Learn Section 1 and about call and response
Lesson 2: Learn Section 2 and more about call and response
Lesson 3: Learn to sing the harmony and bass line
Lesson 4: Record yourself singing up to 3 parts
Lesson 5: Learn and record some percussion parts

The second stream of lessons is aimed at pupils with instruments.

Lesson 1: Learn the melody through singing
Lesson 2: Learn to play the song on instruments (available for all instruments at both an easier and harder level)

Our lessons can be accessed by students both in school and at home.

Information for schools:

Please be aware that any videos that are sent to us by schools will be viewed by members of Nottingham Music Service staff and used to promote the work of NMS on the Nottingham Music Hub website and/or social media platforms. We will assume that all necessary parental permissions are in place to enable us to share videos from schools in this way.
