

## Music Maestros Video Guidelines

We would love you to get involved in our Music Maestros performance opportunity!

Getting involved is really easy:

1. Before you play your piece, take some time to get warmed up, and tune your instrument if you know how to (don't worry if not!)
2. Make sure you've got your backing track ready if you are using one – if you don't want to use a backing track that's fine too!
3. Use a tablet, a phone or a laptop to record yourself playing your piece
4. When you've finished playing, an adult will need to record themselves reading out the permission statement – this is really important because without it we won't be able to respond to your video! A link to a printable version of the permission statement is in the description below this video.
5. Send your video (complete with the permission statement) to [info@nottinghammusic hub.org.uk](mailto:info@nottinghammusic hub.org.uk) with the subject "MUSIC MAESTROS"
6. If your video file is too big to send by email, use wetransfer.com to send the video to [info@nottinghammusic hub.org.uk](mailto:info@nottinghammusic hub.org.uk)
7. The deadline for sending in your performance video is **6 July 2020**

Information for parents: If your child is recording a video at home, it is important that an adult reads out this permission statement on camera at the end of the child's recording:

**"My name is xxxxx and I am the parent / guardian of xxxxx. I give permission for xxxxx to record and upload a video for the Nottingham Music Service. Xxxxx attends xxxxx school. I understand that, once uploaded, the video will be viewed by members of Nottingham Music Service staff and may also be made available for the public to view and to promote the work of the Service on the Nottingham Music Hub website and / or social media platforms. I understand that I can withdraw this permission at any time by emailing Nottingham Music Service."**

Information for schools: Please be aware that any videos that are sent to us by schools will be viewed by members of Nottingham Music service staff and used to promote the work of NMS on the Nottingham Music Hub website and/or social media platforms. We will assume that all necessary parental permissions are in place to enable us to share videos from schools in this way.

Please copy the following text and paste it into your email(s) accompanying the video(s):

**"I confirm that the necessary parental permissions have been received for this video to be shared by me for use by Nottingham Music Service. I understand that, once uploaded, the video will be viewed by Nottingham Music Service staff and will be used to create a larger video, which will be available for the public to view and could also be used to promote the work of the service on their online social media platforms."**
